



## By June 2026

1. Upper body strength.  
Traverse wall to be finished on the long side of the PE container with varying heights of hand holds to enable access for all.
2. Something special for your school – started, frame built.  
Create a large, CD fish, as a project. CDs have been donated.
3. Small world.  
Small world area created in the Chill Out corner. Small world items donated and fairy world items purchased. Chill Out Corner no longer part of OPAL.
4. Sports, gymnastics and sensory.  
Installation of an inground trampoline to provide additional sporting and gymnastics opportunities. Fundraising required. Mr Madden has offered possible help with a digger.
5. Natural Rewilding.  
Rewilding area to include wildflower meadow, sensory areas and cosy spaces. Miniature trees and low level plants to be introduced in the cosy space areas. Wildflower seeds donated.
6. Upper body climbing and gymnastics.  
Larger hanging bars installed to provide more challenging opportunities, particularly for taller and older children. Fundraising required. Mr Madden has offered possible help with a digger. Mr Rainey and Mr Standen have offered to provide materials for and build hanging bars.
7. Transition spaces.  
Improve the “under the sea” wall on the boardwalk. Purchase more decorative items and put them up in the netting.
8. Sensory and chill out.  
Purchase and install a swing frame for the basket swing. Mr Madden has offered possible help with a digger. Money for this donated from the Summer 50<sup>th</sup> Birthday celebrations from The Levin Club.



# OPAL 3 Year Rolling Action Plan



9. Water play.

Water play area by the Dunes area to be revamped. Plastic inserts need replacing and water butts possibly need attaching to the fencing. Unable to purchase replacement plastic inserts. Water no longer accessible in this location, water play area to be closed.

10. Mud kitchen.

Mud kitchen needs some sections replacing and rebuilding.

11. Small World.

Small world area to be created along tree line. Small world items donated and fairy world items purchased. Small fence panels to be used to protect the area.

12. Sensory and music.

Installation of wooden wind chimes under picnic canopy.

13. Pirate Ship improvements – role play.

Pirate ship treasure chest box with dress up items – pirate hats, telescopes, eye patches etc.

14. Music.

Replacement of missing items on music wall. Music wall to be repainted. New items to be purchased and music wall improved.

15. Creativity and role play.

Magnetic (notice) board to be installed on ramp railings, for (eg.) magnetic letters and numbers.

16. Water play.

Water play area on playground to be improved. Possible addition of a water wall.

17. Sensory and gymnastics.

Install a swing frame for a button or seat swing. Mr Madden has offered possible help with a digger. Swing frame has been donated – needs rubbing down and painting.

18. Construction woodchip area.

Build miniature skip and road blocks out of pallets.





## By June 2027

1. Something special for your school – started, frame built, Casey to make with class  
Create a large, CD fish, as a project with Year 6 children. CDs have been donated.
2. Cosy spaces.  
Pallet dens (houses) to be built.
3. Performing.  
Stage backdrop to be painted or installed.
4. Tyres – cosy spaces and zoning.  
Tyres to be filled with sand or soil to prevent zones being moved around. Tyres could be planted up with herbs, small bushes or flowers.
5. Grounds protection.  
Installation of bark chip or shredded rubber underneath the traverse wall, to protect and preserve the grass (very muddy and wet area).
6. Building, and hand-eye coordination.  
Use woodwork area in Lighthouse, maybe once a week, for hammer and nails activities.
7. Tidying and cleaning  
Welly boot cleaners to be made (broom heads on pallets) and placed near the school.
8. Handwashing  
Handwashing station to be bought or made, near the mud kitchen.
9. Knotting stations – fine motor skills  
Knotting stations to be made and placed around the field, to enable children to learn how to tie different types of knots.
10. Mud kitchen.  
Mud kitchen to be rebuilt as sections likely to have degraded over time.



## By June 2028

1. Sensory.  
Bubble machine to be upgraded.
2. Electrical power supply.  
Outdoor power point to be installed on outside of Play Store, so appliances can be plugged in directly, without the need for a long extension cable running through the doorway.
3. Time awareness for adults and children.  
Large display, outdoor digital clock to be sourced and installed on Play Store or mobile block so children and staff have more awareness of time, aiding independence.
4. Balance and coordination, role play.  
Tyre and plank bridge to be built in the swampy area by the kayaks.
5. Rewilding and cosy spaces.  
Tree to be planted in OPAL grass area – fruit perhaps – to also provide shade when it is big enough.
6. Sensory.  
Mirrors to be added to fences or railings. Perhaps railings on playground or fencing behind Dunes area (would also double up as safety for additional line of sight from adults to children in this area).
7. Upper body strength and gymnastics.  
Installation of slackline with hanging exercise equipment in the tree line, such as rings and ropes.
