



# Key Instant Recall Facts



## Year 2 – Summer Term 5

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts with speed and accuracy:

### I know the multiplication and division facts for the ten times table

Children should be able to instantly recall the 10 times table facts below:

$10 \times 1 = 10$	$10 \div 10 = 1$
$10 \times 2 = 20$	$20 \div 10 = 2$
$10 \times 3 = 30$	$30 \div 10 = 3$
$10 \times 4 = 40$	$40 \div 10 = 4$
$10 \times 5 = 50$	$50 \div 10 = 5$
$10 \times 6 = 60$	$60 \div 10 = 6$
$10 \times 7 = 70$	$70 \div 10 = 7$
$10 \times 8 = 80$	$80 \div 10 = 8$
$10 \times 9 = 90$	$90 \div 10 = 9$
$10 \times 10 = 100$	$100 \div 10 = 10$
$10 \times 11 = 110$	$110 \div 10 = 11$
$10 \times 12 = 120$	$120 \div 10 = 12$

#### Key vocabulary:

What is 2 multiplied by 10?  
What is 2 times 10?  
What is 20 divided by 10?

#### Top tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise this KIRF whilst walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise all aspects of the KIRF all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day, or a few facts per week to practise? If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

#### Practical resources and ideas

- Make sure your child is pronouncing the numbers correctly. Eg. thirty instead of thirteen.
- Play test the parent; Can you beat SIRI?; Sing ten times tables songs (YouTube).
- Apply the facts to real life situations: "How many toes have we got in the house?"
